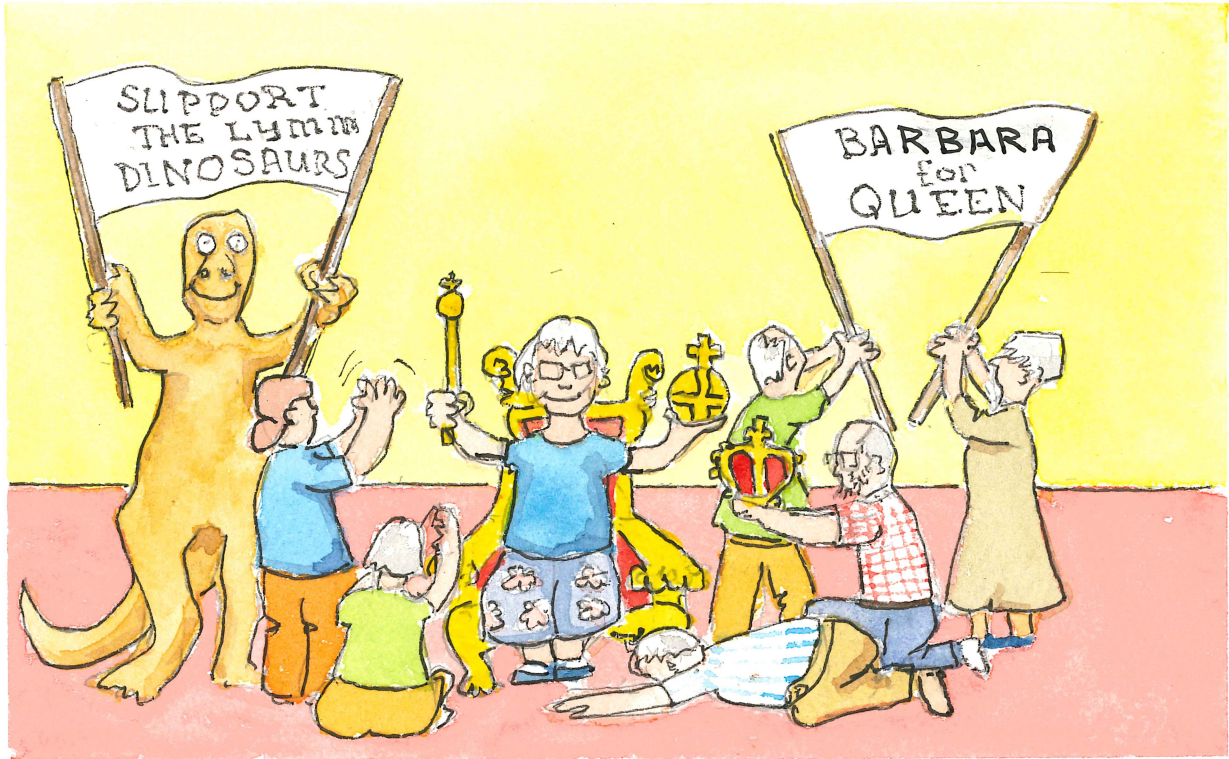


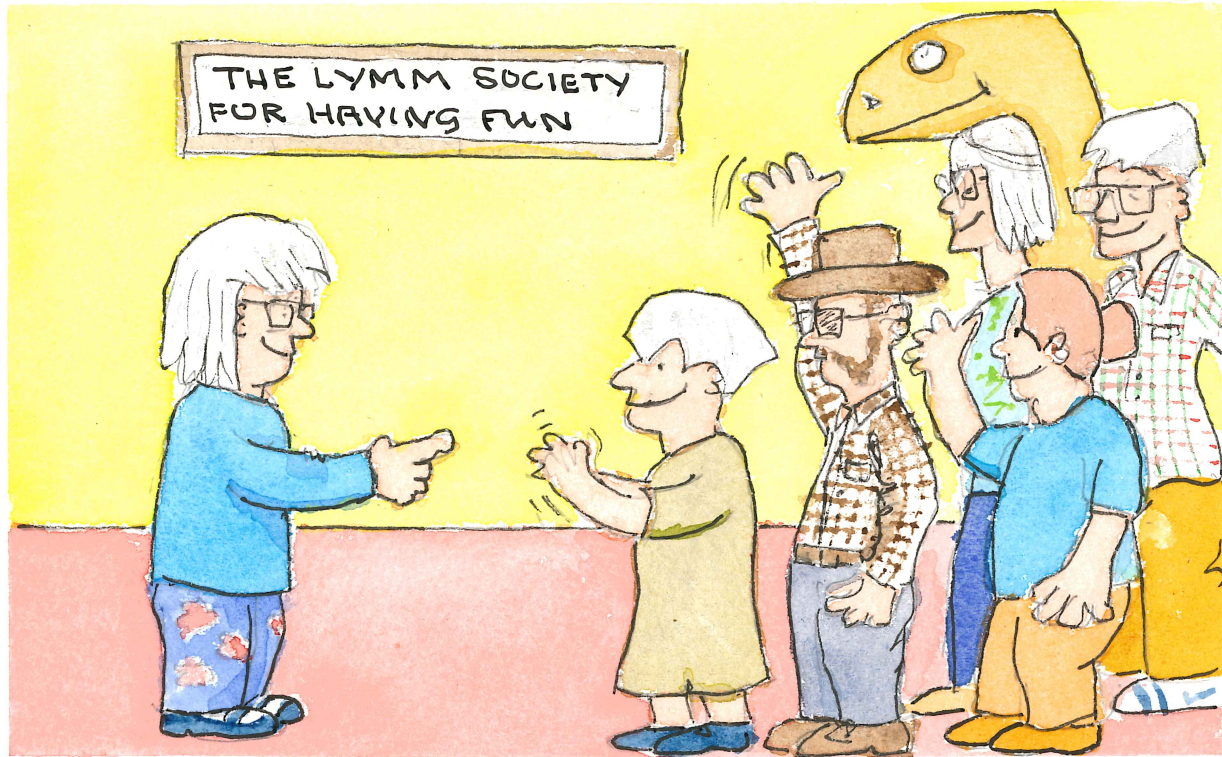
BARBARA TAKES THE WINOS TO DUBROVNIK

Barbara asked the Winos, "Do you want to go to Dubrovnik?"



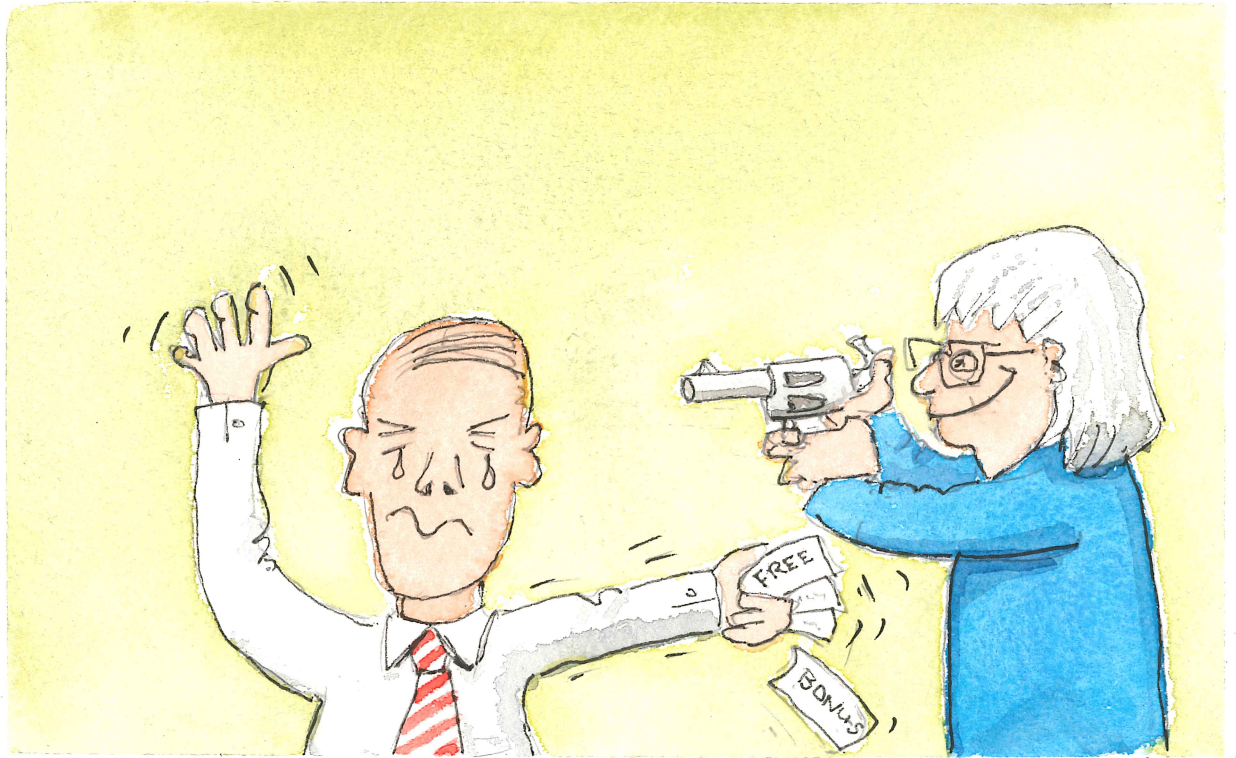
"Dooby-dooby-do!" said the Winos.

stash of discount cards.



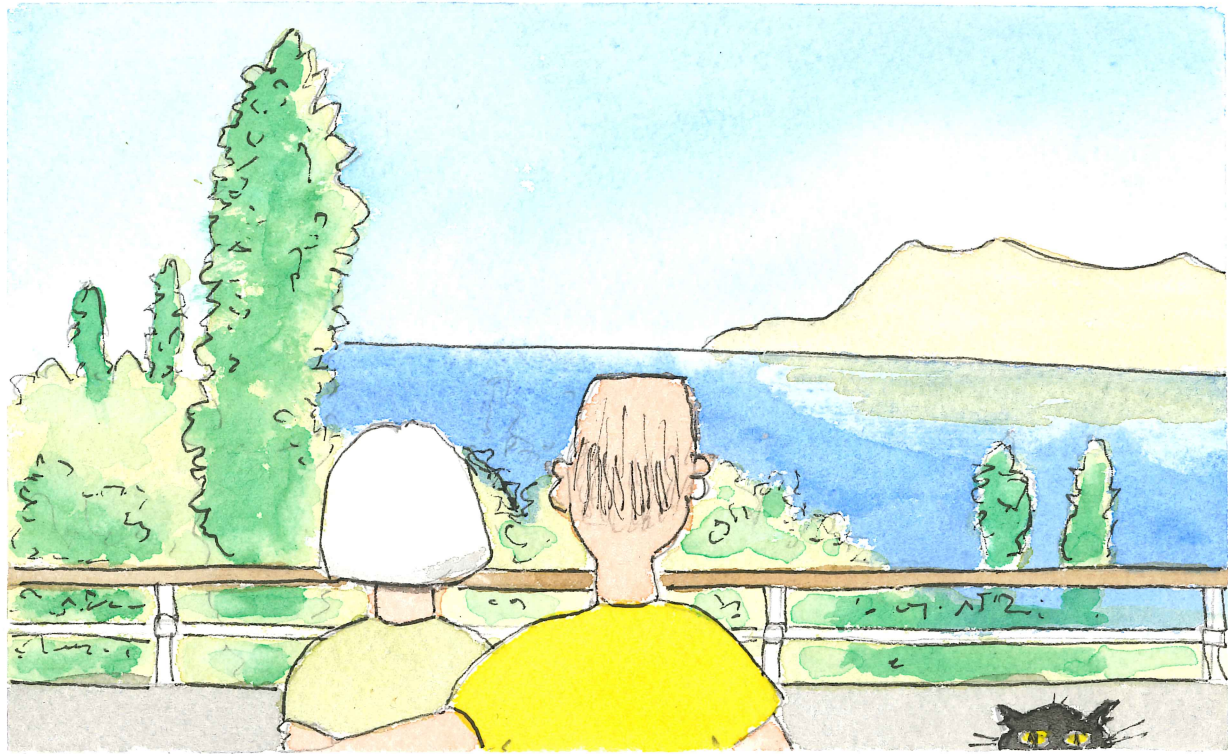
No-one suspected she had them.

Saint Somebody or Other.



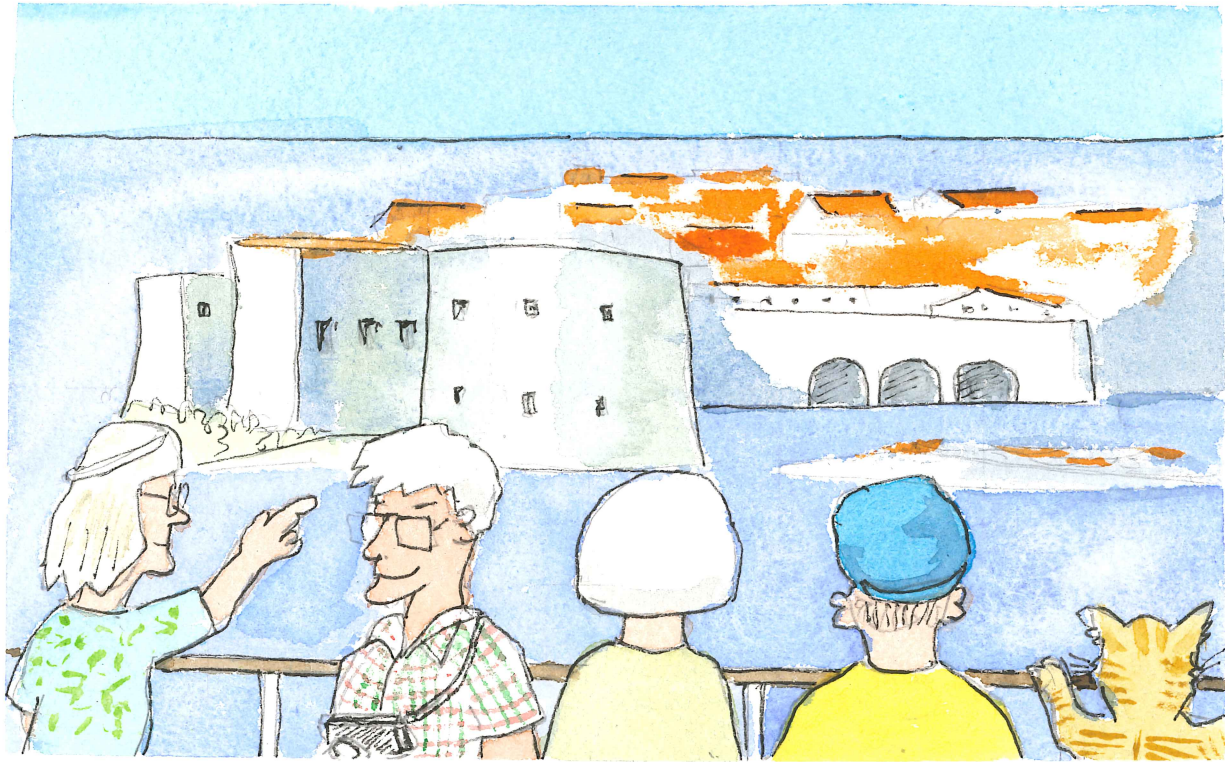
It looked like a church.

by high walls to keep the tourists out.



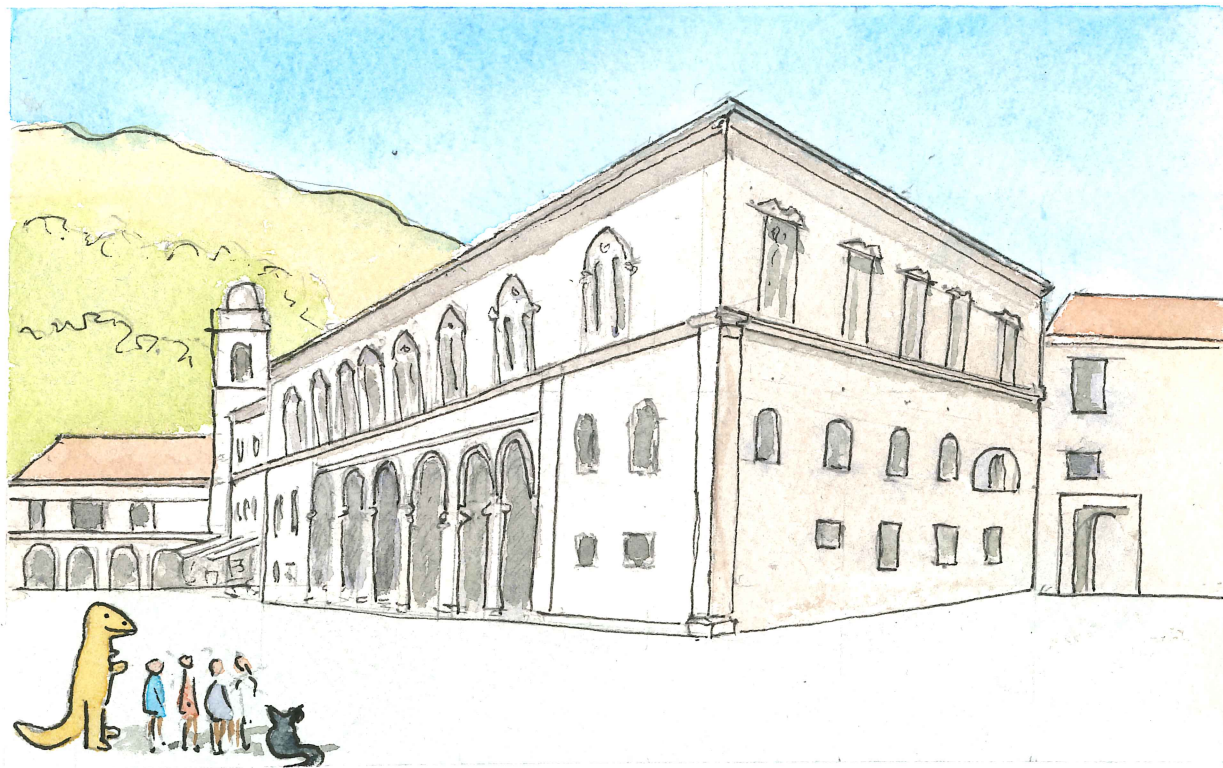
Unfortunately they didn't work.

They had a competition: Who can look the silliest?



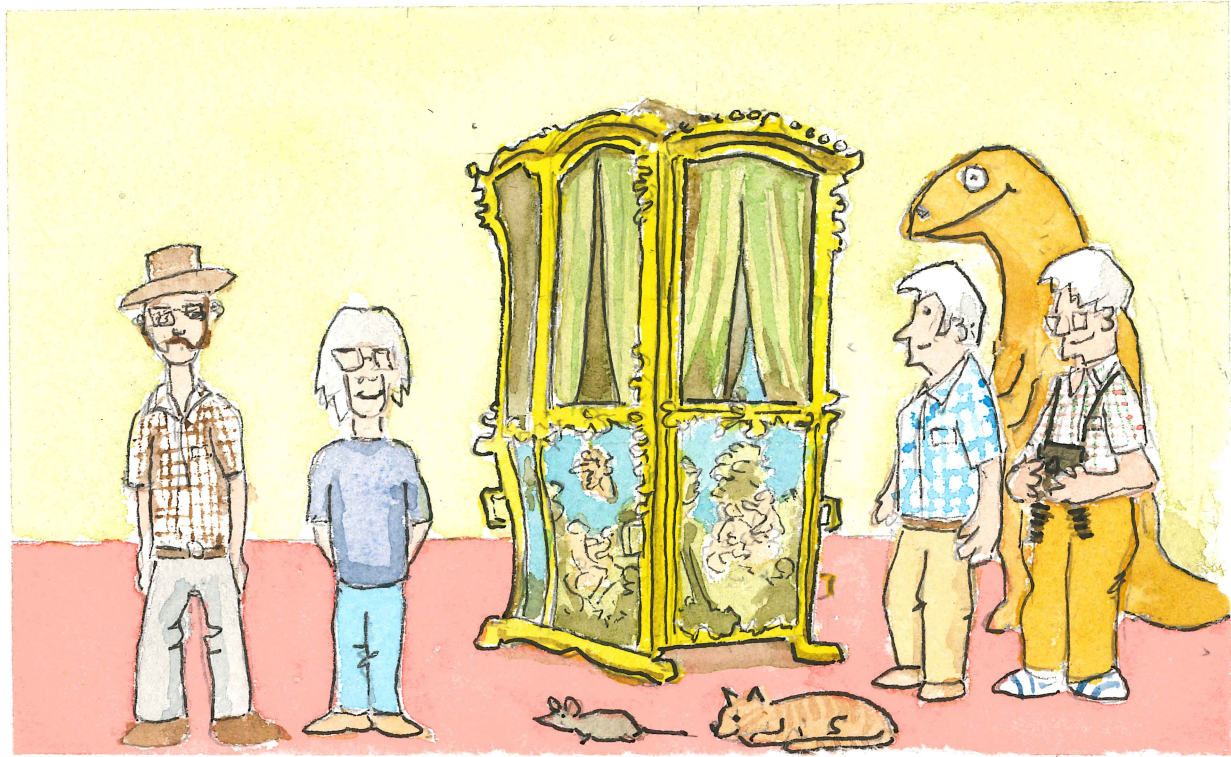
It was a draw.

They went to the Rector's Palace.



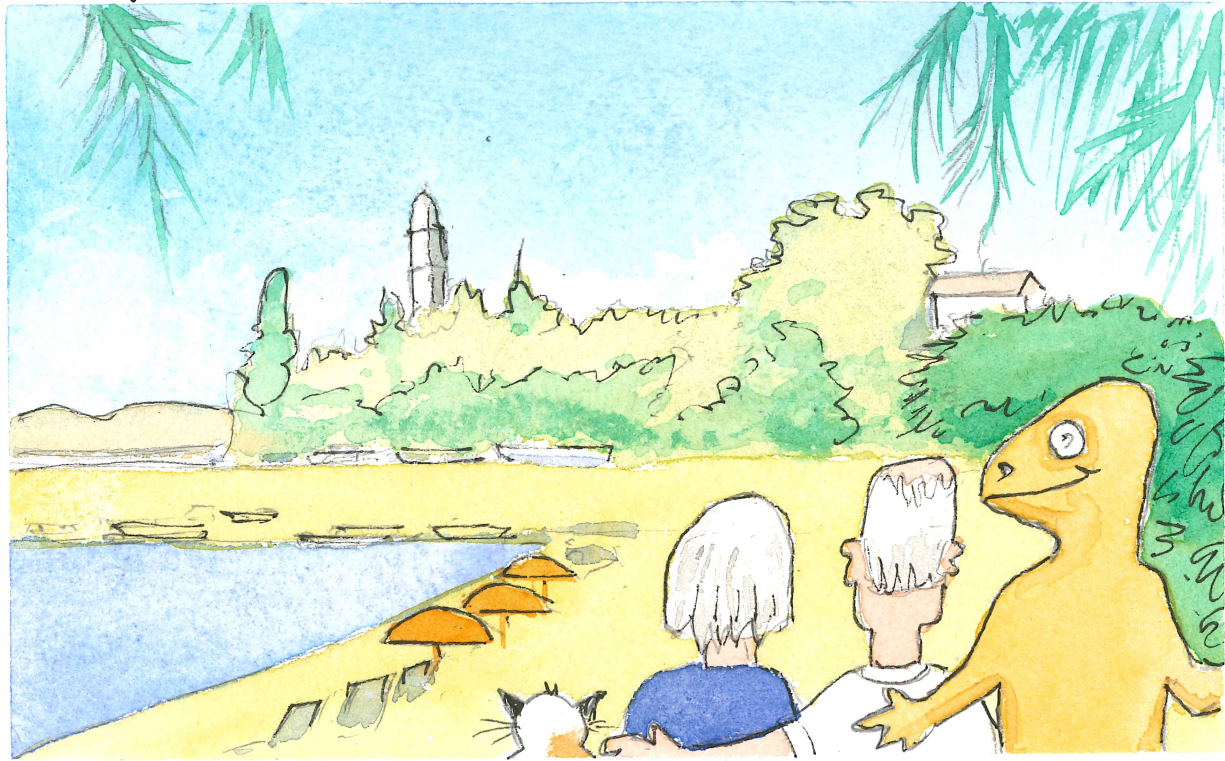
But they still don't know what a "Rector" is.

Some of the Winos had Birthdays while on holiday.



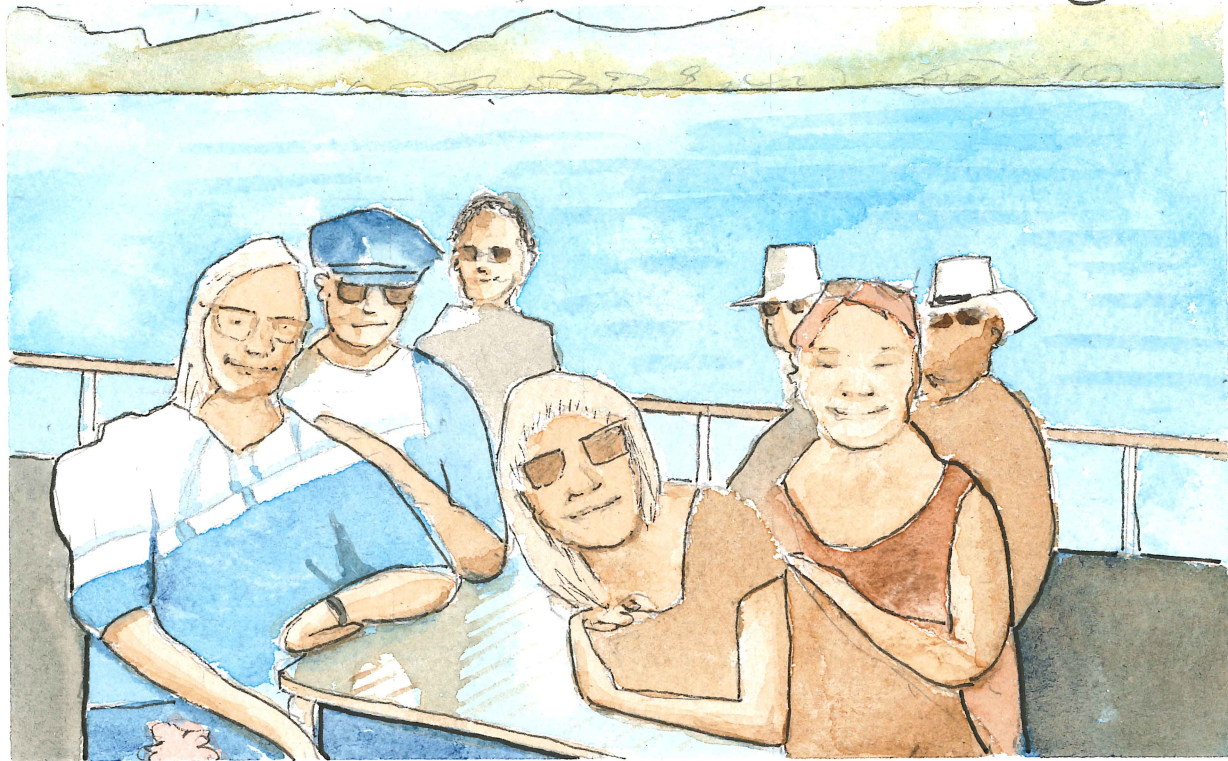
Generously, they bought the drinks all night!
